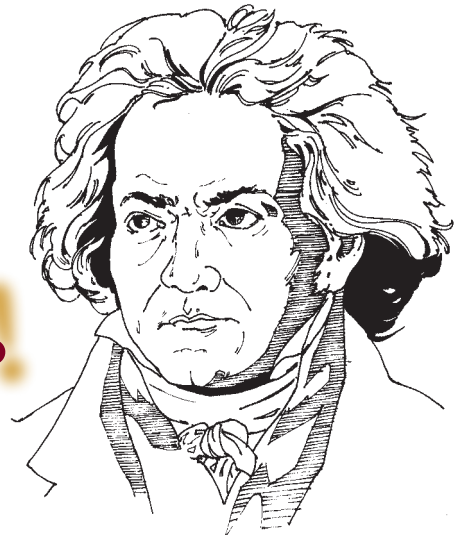




Calling All Singers!
