For 2020, LASYO includes rehearsals on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7 to 9:30 pm. from June 23 through July 28 and culminates in a public concert on August 1. Two of the three conductors (Don Adkins, Göran Berg, Jed da Roza) work with the students at each rehearsal.

Repertoire will include pieces by Corelli (Concerto Grosso No. 9), Haydn (Symphony No. 104, 4th movement), Prokofiev (Suite from *The Love for Three Oranges*), and Johann Strauss (Overture to *Die Fledermaus*).

Registration forms for summer 2020 are due by June 1. The 2020 registration fee is waived. Tuition is due by June 15. Tuition is \$200, with scholarships available and a family discount: tuition for the first child is \$200, but tuition is \$150 for each additional child in a family. High-school graduates (by first rehearsal) and above are welcome at no tuition.

Auditions, at the Bothwell Arts Center in Livermore, are scheduled for Sat. May 9 and Sat. May 16 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.: strings from 9 to 12; winds and percussion from 12:30 to 3.

Rehearsals are on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. at the Bothwell Arts Center in Livermore on June 23 & 25, June 30 & July 2, July 7 & 9, July 14 & 16, July 21 & 23, and July 28 (not July 30).

There will be a **dress rehearsal** at 7 p.m. on Friday July 31 and a **performance** at 8 p.m. on Saturday Aug. 1 at the First Presbyterian Church of Livermore.
